□ To develop the students creativity and imagination making their own toys and / or musical instruments with waste materials.

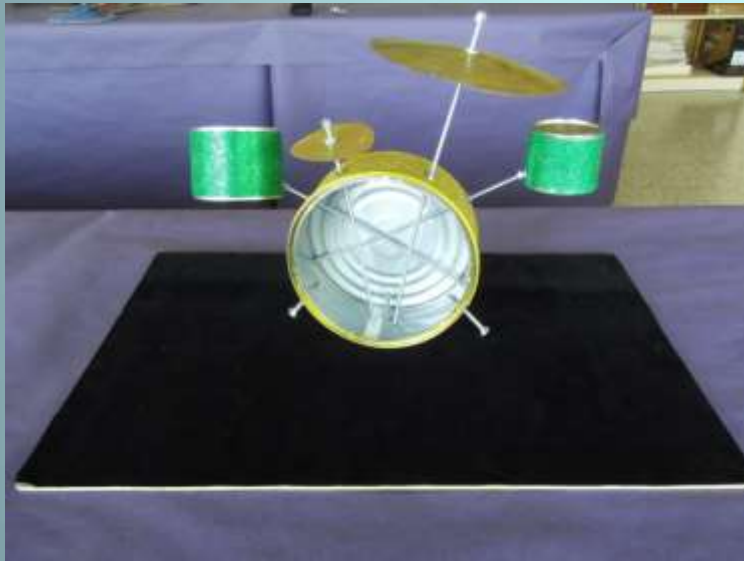

CONCLUSIONS
